With ongoing concerns over the on-going COVID-19 outbreak, The Camp Marshall Board of Directors in partnership with Camp Leadership will continue to enforce the Governor's Stay at Home Advisory. Effective on Wednesday, April 29th 2020, the following restrictions will be enforced for the Stay at Home Advisory Period per the Governor's recommendation which extends until the end of Monday May 18th.   For the purposes of this email, essential personnel will be defined as Camp Marshall office staff, Horse Owners and Full lessees only.
- Should a border need to make additional arrangements as an exception, please contact the Equestrian Director to discuss what options are available.
- Necessary vendors and emergency personnel (Supply Deliveries/Vet Visits /Farriers etc.) will continue to be permitted on premises on a scheduled basis only. Please work with the Directors to coordinate such needs.
- The Indoor Ring, Bathrooms and Rec. Room will all be closed at this time as to limit common use surface contact.
